Why are They Important?

- Given By God Himself
- Design Needs The Parts
- Effective When Employed Together
- Life and Death Issue

Service Gifts – Administration, Exhortation, Faith,
Giving, Helps, Mercy, Serving

Sign Gifts – Miracles, Healing, Tongues,

Some Critical Corrections:

- * That visible means vital *
- * That Public means reward *
 - Heb. 6:10, 1Cor. 3:6-8
- * That What is more important than How *
 - 12:1-2 embracing God's plan not mine
 - 12: 3 humility, working with the others
 - 12:4-6 embracing other gifts

1. Serving / Helping

- serve (diakonia) wait on someone at a table, support, care for
- help (antilempas) laying a hold of, taking up another's weakness
- ability to assist and support others in practical ways that cause public ministries to run smoothly and effortlessly
- Paul in 2 Tim.1:16-17
- usually: self starting, avoid limelight, pleasure in doing quietly in the background. See needs and respond!

2. Exhortation

- 'para' alongside; 'kaleo' to call
- gift of challenging to action, communication of truth that brings response.
 - full of encouragement, helping others get spiritual relevance, offering insightful counsel
 - rebuke challenge to right living
 - 2 Tim. 4:2 exhort with great patience & instruction
 - * With love & concern calling for action on truth *

3. Giving

- ability to avail material resources to God's work with generous frequency cheerfully!
- open hearted, open handed giving without obligation or compulsion but with purpose and compassion joyful
 - don't keep score
 - don't grumble about opportunities
 - don't want people to know where it came from
 - * often seen incorrectly as simply having more*

- 4. Administration / Leadership
 - gk. Nautical term literally steering the ship
- 'he who leads' to preside, occupy a position of authority and responsibility with care
 - Vision to see the goal view to the end
 - Skill to direct people toward the goal define the steps
- * Give steady leadership in stormy days towards the destination God is calling us towards.

5. Showing Mercy

- ability to sense the need & embrace people with comfort, warmth and hope
 - ability to see and serve those the world often ignores
 - perceptive of others pain more than circumstances
 - * Paul tags this gift with a 'how to' cheerfulness
 - not with obligation or burden, not joining in their sorrows but infusing the love & Joy of Christ!
 - * 'like a cool cloth to a hot forehead *

- 6 Faith 1 Cor.12:9
 - all have faith unto salvation in Christ
 - gk. Suggests (heteros vs allos) additional or different
 - ability to discern God's will and pursue it with confidence
 - unusual confidence to lay hold of God's promises with remarkable results.
 - in the fog, chaos, improbable circumstances they are unwavering

*assurance of things hoped for – conviction of things not seen *

So What

- 1. This is Where the Body Becomes Visible
 - what we understand becomes action results happen
- 2. Balance is only Found in All Gifts Functioning
 - no one has all the tools, incapacitated without all
- 3. Gifts Don't Arrive in a Box
 - not all alone, often two or three working together
- 4. Discover your Mix And Get On the Field!
