- *Desire to Hear 'well done good and faithful servant'
- *Desire for Courage do what God asks not man
- *Desire to Use Talents Well serve to see fruit
- *Desire for Maturity steady faith, peace in storms
- Problem My Desires Battle
 - *Want to serve self measure life on my terms
 - *Want to run from difficulty escape tough fights
 - *Want to have stuff distracted by things
 - *Want to be lazy relax, not study pursue relationship

David on this Problem:

vs.7-11 - Love of God and His Word

vs.12-14 –"Who can discern his errors? Forgive my hidden faults. Keep your servant also from willful sins; may they not rule over me. Then will I be blameless, innocent of great transgression. May the words of my mouth and the meditation of my heart be pleasing in your sight, O Lord my Rock and my Redeemer." Psalm 19:12-14

- 1. Grant Me Measuring Moments vs.12
 - need to measure occasionally keep things on track
 - a) Who can discern his errors?
 - we can convince ourselves of many things
 - measure ourselves against culture, others, rules
 - b) Forgive my hidden faults
 - things I have not seen previously now shown
 - things I have pushed down not faced, dealt with

- 2. Give Me a Repentant Heart vs.13
 - hard hearts tend to follow their own paths
 - a) Keep your servant
 - asking God to take an active role
 - prevention from willful sin
 - discipline when in willful sin
 - b) willful sins
 - understanding God choosing my way
 - living in the 'presumption of grace'

- c) rule over me
 - note not free if something rules over you
 - keep me from the tangle of slavery to sin
- 3. Allow Me To Clearly Reflect You In My Life vs.13b,14
 - may my legacy and example be clear and reflective
 - a) blameless
 - living with a clear view of forgiveness, both ways
 - not driven by guilt or judgment of others

- b) innocent of great transgression
 - those with huge consequences for myself
 - those with huge consequences for God's name
 - those that rob me of my potential for God
- c) words and meditations
 - both what I say and what I think
 - takes motives and actions into account
 - speaks of an authentic Love lived out

- d) pleasing in your sight
 - not for what I gain how others see me
 - not for reward better place in heaven
 - not to be more powerful climb the religious ladder
- *So that You Would Be Pleased*
 - 'if you love me, obey my commands'

So What

Going To God With a Renewed Focus

- 1. Grant to Me Measuring Moments
 - expose my thoughts, actions, heart reveal
- 2. Give Me a Repentant Heart
 - keep me, renew in me protect me from hardness
- 3. Allow Me to Clearly Reflect You
 - absence of guilt purity of motives and methods
