Three Big Concerns

- 1. We make this about the destination not the journey.
- 2. That we do not confuse walking like Jesus in obedience with earning our salvation
- You would avoid being here or learning truth due to discomfort or unwillingness for change

Being a disciple of Christ = being known

- our culture and community
 - * personal rights and choices
 - * social engagement w/o contact
 - * self reliance as a value
 - * new having more value than old

Misconceptions In Christian Circles:

- going to a church = belonging to a church
- faith is a personal thing = my faith is a private thing
- institutional or leadership failures = distrust and shifting loyalty necessary

1. Design of God

- Gen 3:8-9 "Then the man and his wife heard the sound of the LORD God as he was walking in the garden in the cool of the day, and they hid from the LORD God among the trees of the garden. 9 But the LORD God called to the man, "Where are you?"

1. Design of God

- Gen 3:8-9
- Designed and created to have vertical and horizontal relationships. To know and be known – to need one another
- From marriage, family, chosen people, nation, church – deliberate

 'pray for one another' (5:16)


- 3. God Expects our Horizontal and Vertical relationships to be evident

- 3. God Expects our Horizontal and Vertical relationships to be evident
 - 1 John 4:12 "Dear friends, since God so loved us, we also ought to love one another. ¹² No one has ever seen God; but if we love one another, God lives in us and his love is made complete in us."
