- cultural realities
- cause of massive problems



Not many of you should become teachers, my brothers, for you know that we who teach will be judged with greater strictness. 2 For we all stumble in many ways. And if anyone does not stumble in what he says, he is a perfect man, able also to bridle his whole body. 3 If we put bits into the mouths of horses so that they obey us, we guide their whole bodies as well. ⁴ Look at the ships also: though they are so large and are driven by strong winds, they are guided by a very small rudder wherever the will of the pilot directs...



⁵So also the tongue is a small member, yet it boasts of great things How great a forest is set ablaze by such a small fire! ⁶ And the tongue is a fire, a world of unrighteousness. The tongue is set among our members, staining the whole body, setting on fire the entire course of life, and set on fire by hell. ⁷ For every kind of beast and bird, of reptile and sea creature, can be tamed and has been tamed by mankind, 8 but no human being can tame the tongue. It is a restless evil, full of deadly poison



⁹With it we bless our Lord and Father, and with it we curse people who are made in the likeness of God. 10 From the same mouth come blessing and cursing. My brothers, these things ought not to be so. 11 Does a spring pour forth from the same opening both fresh and salt water? 12 Can a fig tree, my brothers, bear olives, or a grapevine produce figs? Neither can a salt pond yield fresh water."



- 1. Tongue is Powerful
 - a) Warnings and Wisdom 1-2
 - Those who teach greater accountability

From God Himself

From Others

From Self

- We all teach someone pay attention
- All Stumble in Many Ways
 - perfection found in Christ Alone
- Romans 3:23 all fall short



- b) bits and rudders 3-5
 - 5lb bit controls a 1200lb animal
 - ability to guide and control
 - rudder steers where pilot directs
 - ability to adjust to forces of nature
- *while small the tongue has a massive resume!



- 2. Tongue is Dangerous 5-8
 - a) starting fires
 - under control fire beneficial
 - out of control incredibly destructive
 - ability to affect entire course of life
 - cultural conditions
 - conditions in church
 - unintended results from careless words



- b) untamed by man
 - beasts can be controlled
 - unable to bring tongue under control
 - because what is in our hearts flows out
- Psalm 52:2-4 "Your tongue plots destruction, like a sharp razor, you worker of deceit.³ You love evil more than good, and lying more than speaking what is right. ⁴ You love all words that devour, O deceitful tongue."
 - restless evil, full of deadly poision



- 3. Tongue is Revealing 9-12
 - a) Problem
 - blessing and cursing with same tongue
- Matthew 12:33-37 "33 "Either make the tree good and its fruit good, or make the tree bad and its fruit bad, for the tree is known by its fruit. 34 You brood of vipers! How can you speak good, when you are evil? For out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaks. 35 The good person out of his good treasure brings forth good, and the evil person out of his evil treasure brings forth evil.



³⁶I tell you, on the day of judgment people will give account for every careless word they speak, ³⁷ for by your words you will be justified, and by your words you will be condemned.

- b) two Images
 - water from a spring
 - fig tree & fruit
- what is in the heart is exposed in the words of the person

- 2. We all have potential good or destruction
- 3. None of us can harness this alone

 - bit Lordship of Christ
 - accepting and embracing His direction
 - rudder Scripture, Community of Faith
