# Why This Matters: Short Term Missions

Matt 28:19-20

*Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age.”*



# Why This Matters: Short Term Missions

Acts 1:8

*But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.”*

# Why This Matters: Short Term Missions

Romans 10:14-15

*How then will they call on him in whom they have not believed? And how are they to believe in him of whom they have never heard? And how are they to hear without someone preaching? And how are they to preach unless they are sent? As it is written, “How beautiful are the feet of those who preach the good news!”*

# Why This Matters: Short Term Missions

## Myths about STM's

1. STM's don't matter cause they haven't been around that long
  - This depends on your definition of Short term mission.
  - What we define short term missions as is this
    - Going with intentional purpose to share the love of Christ with missionaries and people who don't know Jesus

# Why This Matters: Short Term Missions

## Biblical examples of STMs

1 Tim 1:3 *“As I urged you when I was going to Macedonia, remain at Ephesus so that you may charge certain persons not to teach any different doctrine, nor to devote themselves to myths and endless genealogies, which promote speculations rather than stewardship from God that is by faith.”*

- Timothy was sent for a specific time and purpose to do gospel work



# Why This Matters: Short Term Missions

Also.....

Phil 2:25-28 *“I have thought it necessary to send to you Epaphroditus my brother and fellow worker and fellow soldier, and your messenger and minister to my need, for he has been longing for you all and has been distressed because you heard that he was ill. Indeed he was ill, near to death.*”



# Why This Matters: Short Term Missions

*But God had mercy on him, and not only on him but on me also, lest I should have sorrow upon sorrow. I am the more eager to send him, therefore, that you may rejoice at seeing him again, and that I may be less anxious.”*

- Epaphroditus was sent by the Church in Philippi to help Paul with the Gospel work

# Why This Matters: Short Term Missions

## Myths about STM's

1. STM's don't matter cause they haven't been around that long
2. STM's help only the people going, not those who we are going to serve
  - We DO NEED to make sure that we are effective when we do STMs
  - We expect to see life change both in those we send and those who receive

# Why This Matters: Short Term Missions

Why do Short Term Missions matter (4 reasons)

## 1. Obedience

- Jesus commanded that we go and make disciples. (Matt 28:19-20)
- Jesus said that we would be his witnesses in the whole earth (Acts 1:8)
- This is not only for some churches but all.
  - How are we a part of witnessing in other parts of the world? STMs are a part of our strategy for this.



# Why This Matters: Short Term Missions

Why do Short Term Missions matter (4 reasons)

1. Obedience

2. Potential for discipleship

- Those who we send are given a great opportunity to allow God to shape them
- We aim to see people encouraged in their discipleship journey on the ground
- God can do amazing things in a short amount of time when we make ourselves available.

# Why This Matters: Short Term Missions

Why do Short Term Missions matter (4 reasons)

1. Obedience
2. Potential for discipleship
3. Potential for Evangelism
  - In Canada most people are not interested in hearing about Jesus
  - This is not the case everywhere. There are people who are hungry to hear the “good news” of Jesus

# Why This Matters: Short Term Missions

Why do Short Term Missions matter (4 reasons)

1. Obedience
2. Potential for discipleship
3. Potential for Evangelism
4. We reflect the heart of Jesus
  - STM's aren't the only way this can be developed in us but it has been significant
  - Our capacity to love others grows
  - We develop an "available" posture

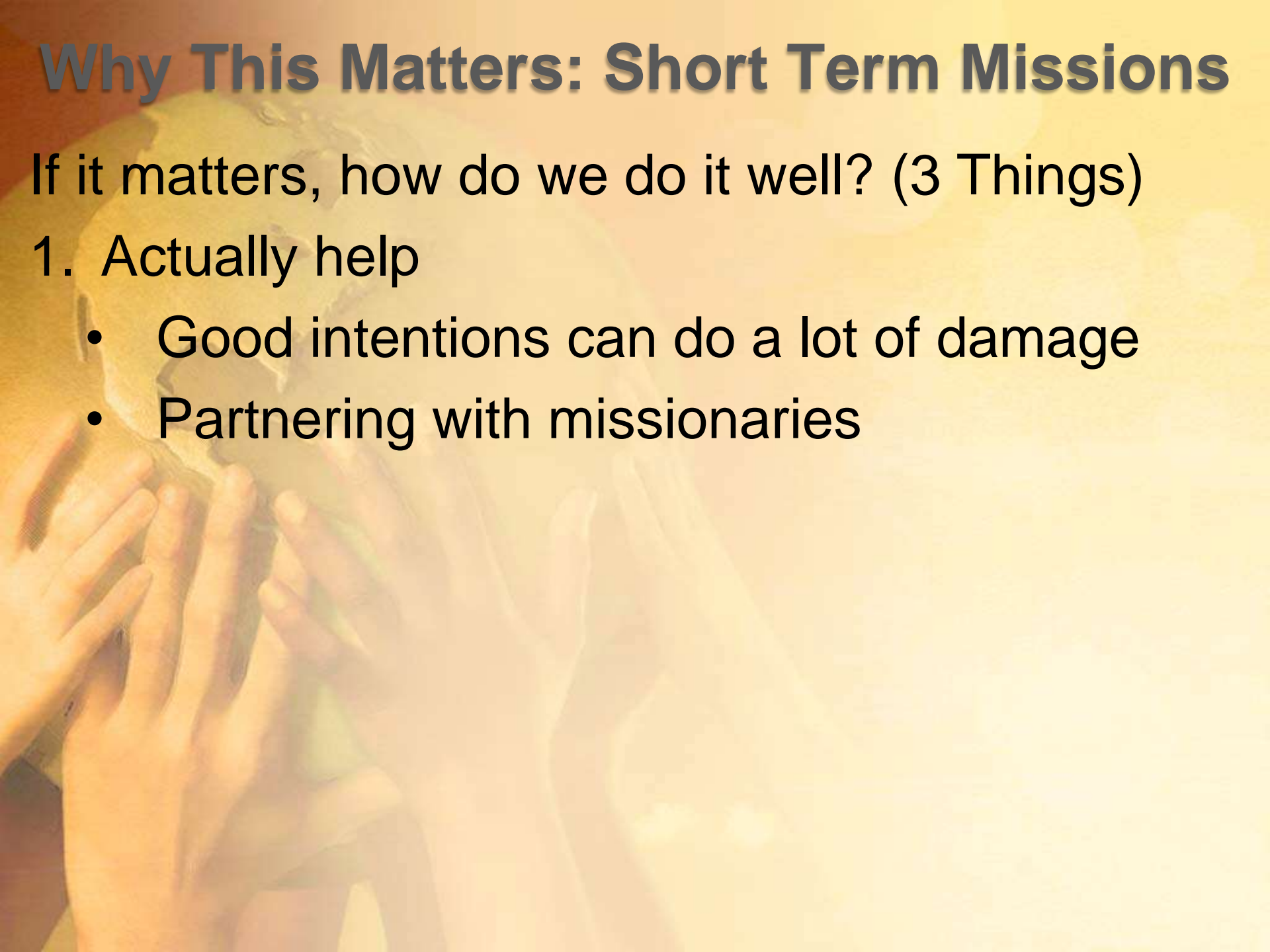


# Why This Matters: Short Term Missions

- Partnering with missionaries
