 Difficult to Love & Lose Friends
 - shared life win's and losses together
 - share spiritual experience
 - trusted God, prayed, saw Him work
 - learning & growing together
- Doing this well important
 - both sides, leaving and staying

1. Grieve Well

- Acts 20:17-38... Paul & the church in Ephesus
 - a) identify the loss
 - shared life & spiritual experiences
 - new reality
 - b) express what matters
 - thanksgiving what has been important
- encouragement you have been used by God in my life
 - markers identifying important growth

- c) commend one another to God
- 32-36 "And when he had said these things, he knelt down and prayed with them all. ³⁷ And there was much weeping on the part of all; they embraced Paul and kissed him, ³⁸ being sorrowful most of all because of the word he had spoken, that they would not see his face again. And they accompanied him to the ship."

2. Gain Perspective

- a) God is involved and able
- Rom. 8:35-39 "Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or danger, or sword? ³⁶ As it is written, "For your sake we are being killed all the day long; we are regarded as sheep to be slaughtered."37 No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us. 38 For I am sure that neither death nor life, nor angels nor rulers, nor things present nor things to come, nor powers, ³⁹ nor height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord.'

- b) Seasons of Life can be embraced
 - Eccl 3
- c) I can Trust God in the Unknown
 - to bring others into our body
 - to prepare a place for you elsewhere
 - to build His church His way
 - that we have eternity together

3. Extend a Blessing to One Another

- a) Send them with a Blessing
- Acts 13 ""Set apart for me Barnabas and Saul for the work to which I have called them." ³ Then after fasting and praying they laid their hands on them and sent them off."
 - b) Build up and pray for one another

- 1 Thess 3:11ff "Now may our God and Father himself, and our Lord Jesus, direct our way to you, ¹² and may the Lord make you increase and abound in love for one another and for all, as we do for you, ¹³ so that he may establish your hearts blameless in holiness before our God and Father, at the coming of our Lord Jesus with all his saints."
