- a) Who we are speaking to!
- Psalm 33:6-9 "By the word of the LORD the heavens were made, and by the breath of his mouth all their host. ⁷ He gathers the waters of the sea as a heap; he puts the deeps in storehouses. ⁸ Let all the earth fear the LORD; let all the inhabitants of the world stand in awe of him! ⁹ For he spoke, and it came to be; he commanded, and it stood firm."
 - b) almighty God Invites us to come to him
 - provided the path
 - clearly tells us to come to him in prayer

- John 16:24 "Truly, truly, I say to you, whatever you ask of the Father in my name, he will give it to you. ²⁴ Until now you have asked nothing in my name. Ask, and you will receive, that your joy may be full"
- Matt. 7:7-8 "Ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you. 8 For everyone who asks receives, and the one who seeks finds, and to the one who knocks it will be opened"

- c) Promise of God to hear & respond
- Psalm 40:1-3 "I waited patiently for the LORD; he inclined to me and heard my cry. ² He drew me up from the pit of destruction, out of the miry bog, and set my feet upon a rock, making my steps secure.³ He put a new song in my mouth, a song of praise to our God. Many will see and fear, and put their trust in the LORD."

- Psalm 51:17 "The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit; a broken and contrite heart, O God, you will not despise"
- d) Scripture full of accounts of God responding to the prayers of his people
 - Ex. 3:1-10

Look at prayer in our place & time

1. God Knew where You would be in time & Place

- Acts 17:24-27 "24 The God who made the world and everything in it, being Lord of heaven and earth, does not live in temples made by man, 25 nor is he served by human hands, as though he needed anything, since he himself gives to all mankind life and breath and everything. ²⁶ And he made from one man every nation of mankind to live on all the face of the earth, having determined allotted periods and the boundaries of their dwelling place, 27 that they should seek God, and perhaps feel their way toward him and find him. Yet he is actually not far from each one of us."

- Eph. 2:10 "10 For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them."

2. Your Situation is Not a Surprise to God

- nothing about your times that is a surprise to God
- God is active in governments
- Proverbs 21:1 "The king's heart is a stream of water in the hand of the LORD; he turns it wherever he will."
- Proverbs 19:21 "Many are the plans in the mind of a man, but it is the purpose of the Lord that will stand."
 a) Jesus Model
 - reality of Roman Occupation & Persecution
 - teaching thy kingdom, thy will
 - practice garden prayer

- b) be open about your situation
 - God is already aware
 - allow heart alignment not my will be done
 - song I pray for you
- Luke 6:27-28 "But I say to you who hear, Love your enemies, do good to those who hate you, ²⁸ bless those who curse you, pray for those who abuse you."

3. Instructions – Pray for our Leaders

- 1 Tim. 2:1-4 "First of all, then, I urge that supplications, prayers, intercessions, and thanksgivings be made for all people, ² for kings and all who are in high positions, that we may lead a peaceful and quiet life, godly and dignified in every way. ³ This is good, and it is pleasing in the sight of God our Savior, ⁴ who desires all people to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth."
 - all people/kings & authorities singled out
 - thanksgivings must have been hard for them
 - connected to life and witness
 - important to the will of God that all be saved

b) clear call in 1 Peter 2:18-25

"Be subject for the Lord's sake to every human institution, whether it be to the emperor as supreme, ¹⁴ or to governors as sent by him to punish those who do evil and to praise those who do good. 15 For this is the will of God, that by doing good you should put to silence the ignorance of foolish people. 16 Live as people who are free, not using your freedom as a cover-up for evil, but living as servants of God. ¹⁷ Honor everyone. Love the brotherhood. Fear God. Honor the emperor."

4. Persisting in Prayer

- Rom. 12:12... "Rejoice in hope, be patient in tribulation, be constant in prayer."
- 1 Thess. 5:14-18... "And we urge you, brothers, admonish the idle, encourage the fainthearted, help the weak, be patient with them all. ¹⁵ See that no one repays anyone evil for evil, but always seek to do good to one another and to everyone. ¹⁶ Rejoice always, ¹⁷ pray without ceasing, ¹⁸ give thanks in all circumstances; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you."
