The Root of Poverty and our Response

Dr. Wess Stafford, the former Compassion International President, had this to say about poverty:

"At its very core, poverty is a mindset that goes far beyond the tragic circumstances. It is the cruel, destructive message that gets whispered into the ears of millions by the enemy Satan himself: "Give up! You don't matter. Nobody cares about you. Look around you: Things are terrible. Always have been, always will be. Think back. Your grandfather was a failure. Your parents couldn't protect or take care of you. Now it's your turn. You, too, will fail. So just give up!"

What is poverty?

- Physical/Economic (money/wealth, food, water, clothes, shelter)
- Emotional (self-worth)
- Social (healthy relationships)
- Spiritual (broken relationship with God)


There are 178 uses of the word <u>poor</u> in Scripture.

Matthew 26:6-11 6 While Jesus was in Bethany in the home of Simon the Leper, ⁷ a woman came to him with an alabaster jar of very expensive perfume, which she poured on his head as he was reclining at the table. 8 When the disciples saw this, they were indignant. "Why this waste?" they asked. 9 "This perfume could have been sold at a high price and the money given to the poor." 10 Aware of this, Jesus said to them, "Why are you bothering this woman? She has done a beautiful thing to me. 11 The poor you will always have with you, but you will not always have me.

 - o Culture Shock




- Fundraising projects
